In the interest of user safety, Makita NZ Ltd is undertaking a voluntary safety recall of Makita Petrol Chainsaw models DCS6401, PS6400, DCS7301, PS7300, DCS7901 and PS7900 for replacement of band guard and braking mechanism.

HAZARD: The automatic chain brake activation is not smooth and when a kickback occurs the chain brake may not stop the chain as expected. A rotating chain after kickback poses an injury hazard to users. (No injuries have been reported).

WHAT TO DO: Stop using your chainsaw (See the model above) immediately. All serial number will be adapted to recall.

Take it into the store you bought it from or to a nearest Makita Authorised Service Agent.
